Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act

Dear Mrs./Mr.,

We received your request for information regarding conflict minerals in our products.

As your request is very general, it is in all reasonability, not possible to obtain all the specific information requested.

We understand that these requests are becoming more prevalent in the industry in light of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Act of 2012, and we take these requests seriously.

Consistent with our core values we recognizes our social responsibility not to support or contribute to the violence and human rights violations associated with the mining of conflict minerals of Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten or Gold ("Conflict Minerals") as defined in the applicable US legislation.

To the best of our knowledge, ERIKS NV does not directly purchase Conflict Minerals sourced from any of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, or Zambia ("Covered Countries").

We source our components and products from reputable and approved suppliers. Although some components or products we purchase might contain these Conflict Minerals, we have no reason to believe that they contain minerals sourced from Covered Countries.
